- ⊕ Where have you seen flowers like this?

- ⊕ Which season do you think this picture was taken in?
- ⊕ Which part of the flower has a circular shape?
- ⊕ How many daffodils can you see?
- ⊕ Is there an odd or even number of daffodils?
- ⊕ How many petals does each daffodil have?
- ⊕ Is there an odd or even number of petals?
- ⊕ If there was ‘one more’ daffodil, how many would there be?
- ⊕ If a daffodil had one less petal, how many petals would it have?
- ⊕ Can you find a line of symmetry on a daffodil?
- ⊕ If I halved the number of petals on a daffodil, how many would I have?
- ⊕ Do you think all the daffodils are the same height?
- ⊕ What colour is the daffodil below the first yellow and orange daffodil?
- ⊕ How would you sort these daffodils into 2 piles?
